THE FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT ON FIRST NATION LAND MANAGEMENT

The *Framework Agreement on First Nation Land Management* was developed in the early 1990s by 14 First Nations Chiefs. The *Framework Agreement* gives First Nations the option of developing a Land Code to govern their own reserve lands.

The *First Nations Land Management Act* was developed in 1999. It was developed as part of Canada's obligations under the *Framework Agreement on First Nation Land Management*. This Act gave Canada the authority to sign the *Framework Agreement* and transfer the responsibility of reserve land management to First Nations that have voted to accept a Land Code.
